Modified Playing Rules - Effective Spring 2005

Number of Players	6 v 6 Maximum 5 field players + 1 GK 4 players must be present to start a game
Roster Size	12 Maximum
Field Dimensions	Rectangular: Between 45-60 yards by 35-40 yards recommended
Markings	The field of play is divided into two halves by a halfway line. The center mark is indicated at the midpoint of the halfway line. A circle with a radius of 8 yards is marked around it.
Goals	6 x 18 and 7 x 21 are acceptable
Goal Area	Conform to FIFA.
Penalty Area	The Penalty Area: A penalty area is defined at each end of the field as follows: Two lines are drawn at right angles to the goal line, fourteen (14) yards from the inside of each goalpost. These lines extend into the field of play for a distance of fourteen (14) yards and are joined by a line drawn parallel with the goal line. The area bounded by these lines and the goal line is the penalty area. Within each penalty area a penalty mark is made ten (10) yards from the midpoint between the goalposts and equidistant to them. An arc of a circle with a radius of eight (8) yards from each penalty mark is drawn outside the penalty area.
Flag Posts	Conform to FIFA.
Corner Arc	Conform to FIFA.
Ball	Size 4
Duration of play	25 minute halves - 5 minute half time
Offsides	DOES <u>NOT</u> APPLY
Free Kicks & Corner Kicks	Conform to FIFA with the exception that all opponents are at least 8 yards from the ball.
Start & Restart of Play	Conform to FIFA with the exception that all opponents are at least 8 yards from the ball.
Fouls & Misconduct	Conform to FIFA.
Substitutions	UNLIMITED and at any stoppage. No substitutions on penalty kicks.
Penalty Kicks	Conform to FIFA.
Throw-In	Conform to FIFA.
Goal Kick	Conform to FIFA.
Ball In & Out of Play	Conform to FIFA.
Method of Scoring	Conform to FIFA.
